

Awards will be given to the top units in each category conforming to the theme of the parade. The Louis Fobare Trophy is awarded to best of the parade.

EXPLANATION OF CLASSES:

BUSINESS: Entries sponsored by businesses and constructed by the employees of a business.

CIVIC or VOLUNTEER GROUP: Entries sponsored and constructed by fraternal organizations and groups, such as the American Cancer Society, Rotary Club, etc.

YOUTH GROUP: Entries that are not directly school-related, such as Scout groups, Peewee hockey, etc.

SCHOOL GROUP: All school-organized groups; this includes Elementary, Middle, High School and College groups.

INDEPENDENT GROUP: Entries by groups who get together for the purpose of participating in the parade (neighbors, family, friends, etc.).

ANIMAL UNIT: Any use of live animals qualifies for this class.

GENERAL PARADE RULES AND INFORMATION

Parade line-up: 12 Noon, Lake Colby Drive

Parade start: 1:00 PM Sharp!

1. Unit numbers may be picked up from Parade Chairman Eric Foster at the Vet's Club, 173 Broadway (next to Hyde Mobil) from 11 a.m. until 12 noon on parade day. **Unit numbers must be displayed on the RIGHT FRONT of each unit.**
2. Floats and vehicles are limited to 12' height. Operators must have a valid driver's license and insurance.
3. The village roads are closed at Noon. You will need to be in place before then.
4. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED.**
5. **DO NOT THROW CANDY OR HEAVY OBJECTS from the floats! Please have someone walking beside the float to hand out candy, etc.**
6. **Do not carry or use real weapons or fire projectiles, or include real fires or other dangerous elements.**
7. Any float, car, or marching unit not behaving in a proper manner will be asked to leave the parade.
8. Please maintain a 50-foot distance between units at all times.
9. At the parade finish: Floats will turn right onto the LaPan Highway, proceed beyond the overpass, and park on the shoulder of the highway.
10. Band and float judges have the final decision in the awarding of prizes. Questions, problems, and/or suggestions should be directed to Eric Foster, Parade Chairman.
11. Awards will be available **after** the band concert held in the Harrietstown Town Hall.
